John is an advanced personal trainer and sports nutritionist and has worked extensively with shooters including disabled shooters. From 2013—2014 he was lead therapist with the GB Disabled Target Shooting team and in 2013 he spoke at the CPSA Conference on working with disabled athletes.

In 2014 he was part of the Commonwealth Games Development Team, Shotgun Sports therapist and in 2014 spoke at the ICSI AGM on post Commonwealth Games feedback.

From 2013—2017 John has worked with numerous National bodies to support shooting athletes including those para-athletes preparing for major competitions.

It is well worth checking with CPSA HQ if you have not taken a Safety Officers Course in the last 5 years, if you are currently qualified.

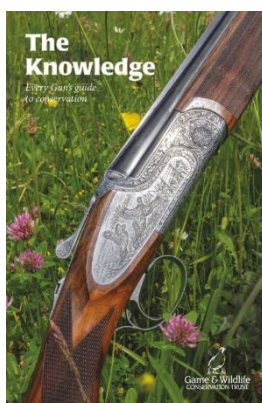
