#### Home Office issue additional Licensing Authorities and Shooters

Malcolm Plant writes, The Home Office recently announced that the additional guidance for use by the police and shooters is now available on-line. This is not a legal requirement as is the Statutory Guidance, but simply additional advice.

"This e-mail is to advise you that we have today issued a fully revised version of the non-statutory firearms guidance Firearms licensing law - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk) to include all of the legislative changes that have been made since April 2016.

This guidance should be read alongside the Statutory guidance for police on firearms licensing - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk), which was published on 20 October and came into effect on 1 November."


