Launch of New ICSI Website

Over the past several months the Institute has been using a web site which has been the basis for a new and functional website. We are grateful to Richard Halsall for all his efforts to see us over this difficult time after the demise of our previous website.

Over the past month this interim site has been turned into a much-improved web site which members will find easier to navigate, allow them to edit their own profile, pay their subscriptions and shop item, book and pay for courses and access information and News Shots.

For the public it will provide a site where they can find an instructor or coach based on google maps, view their profile and, if they wish, contact the instructor or coach.

We are due to launch this new website before the AGM and for those you who have registered with the existing web site, your log in details will remain the same. For those who have not yet registered with the web site, you will receive a username and password via an email with the next two weeks.

Everyone will receive an email once the website goes live so that you may log onto the members area, edit your profile, and explore the site.

Note that the issuing of firearm or shot gun certificates are dealt with separately - see chapters 7, 10 and 11

Exemptions

- 1. Carry for sporting purpose.
- 2. Rifle/Pistol Club or cadet corps
- Miniature rifle range.
- 4. Under supervision of someone 21 years or over.
- 5. Secure gun cover (but this exemption is not available in respect of air pistols).
- On private land with the consent of the occupier.
 NOTE air weapons are subject to certification in Scotland (see Chapter 7)


