REVISED FIREARMS LICENSING STATUTORY GUIDANCE FEB 2023

Dr. Malcolm Plant, our representative on the British Shooting Sports Council, has sent a link to the latest revised statutory licensing guidance, issued by the Home Office, which Police firearms enquiry officers and managers should be using in their role to grant and renew firearms certificates and licences.

However, Malcolm warns that in light of recent fatal shootings there may be further changes.

Designed for candidates wishing to refine the various aspects gathered in the preceding workshop, returning once they have had the chance to 'try them on for size'.


Observation and Interpretation Workshop

ZOOM SEMINAR NUTRICIAN AND FITNESS


On Monday 13th February 2023, WO2 Steve Hughes (QMSI) gave a fantastic presentation on the relationship between, nutrition, fitness and performance.

His technical but clear presentation looked at food intake, sleep and sleep patterns, warming up exercises and how these relate to performance. As a clay shooter and part of the Army Clay Shooting Team, Steve was able to relate his professional expertise to the sport of shooting.

His present post requires him to advise his Major General on the fitness of soldiers undertaking new deployments and so his expertise has a critical real world application. As well as being a fitness instructor he is also an advanced paramedic and so has a practical and academic background.
